This man who had lodged at Castleacre for many months past his wife being in the House of Industry at Wicklewood was employed as a labourer by Mr Seppings of this parish and when he was last seen alive was left feeding bullocks with turnips at Mr Sepping's Field Barn on Wednesday evening Jan 20th between five and six o'clock. From that time till Monday Feb 1 he had been missing when he was found dead by Mr Sepping's warrener lying upon his back towards the Bank side in a deep ditch round what is called the seven acre piece in the field. No marks of violence appeared about his body. Coroner's Inquest taken Feb 3rd verdict : died by visitation of God. Nb since I made the above entry I understand from Harpley's widow that he belonged to the parish of Wicklewood and that she now lies in a cottage near the House of Industry there.
